The right hand, representing the Mind, is sewn to the left hand, representing the Sacred Heart, by the fifth and tenth steps of Jacobs Ladder.

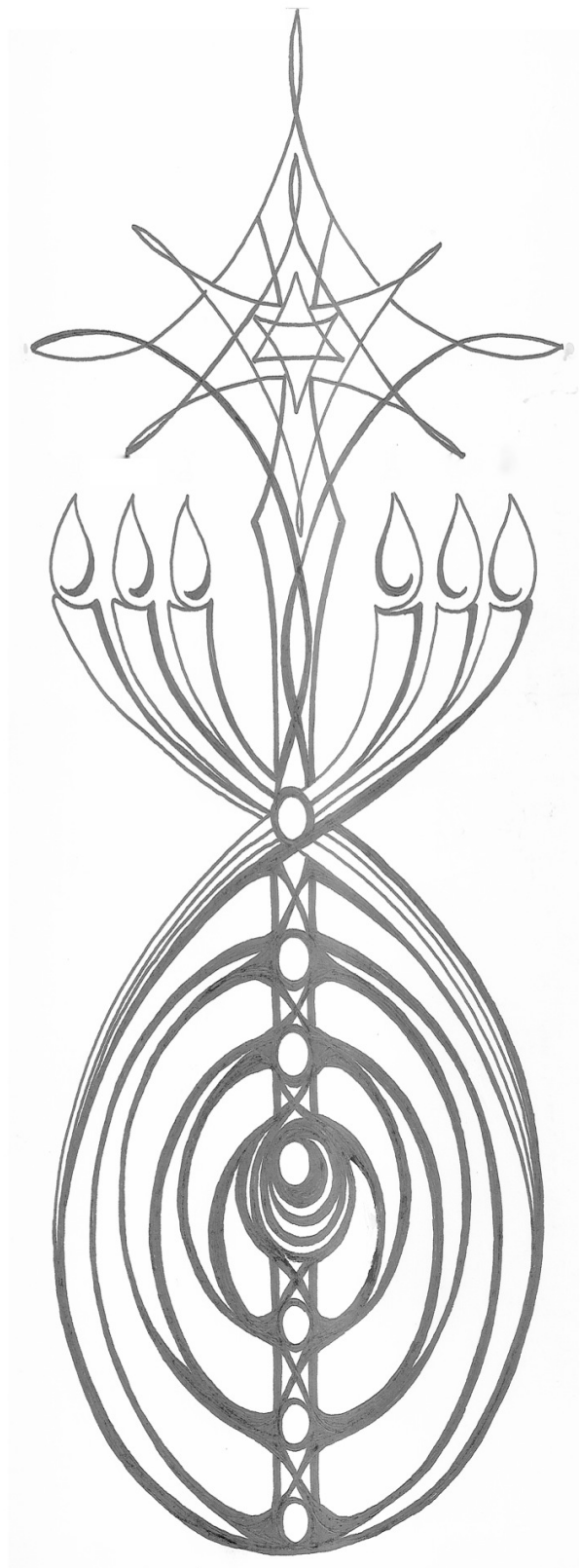
